In the past, we have been proud to present a number of significant cars to an appreciative audience at Radnor. Our features have included Rolls-Royce, Packard, Alfa Romeo, Pierce-Arrow, Bugatti, and Ferrari. From these great marques, our past Best-of-Show winners have included John Moir's 1925 Voisin C3L Berline Transformable, John W. Marriott, Jr.'s 1938 Darracq/Talbot Lago T-150-C Cabriolet by Figoni & Falaschi and Joseph Cassini's Bentley Speed Six. Last year's Best-of-Show was the beautiful 1947 Delahaye of Jack Rich. As winner of the 2008 Timeless Elegance Award for his 1929 Rolls-Royce Phantom I by Hibbard & Darrin, James Caldwell was presented a handsome Breitling watch by Govberg Jewelers.
